Brazilian Candidates with Secondary Education + ENEM

- Identification document (Passport);
- Diploma and certificate of completion of secondary education, duly authenticated by the official education authorities of the country of origin and recognized by the Portuguese diplomatic or consular authority in that country, or authenticated with the Hague Apostille;
- Certificate of equivalence to Portuguese secondary education (to be requested from a Portuguese secondary education institution);
- Self-declaration, under oath, stating that the applicant does not hold Portuguese nationality and is not subject to any conditions preventing application to the competition for international students;
- Visa or Residence Permit/Card;
- Power of Attorney, when the application is submitted by a legal representative;

Candidates of Other Nationalities with Secondary Education

All documents written in a language other than French, English, or Spanish must be accompanied by a translation into Portuguese, duly certified by the competent authorities.

Entrance Exams

1. Applicants who can provide proof of passing nationally recognized final examinations in the secondary education subjects corresponding to the entrance tests required for that year's admission to the programme are exempt from taking the aptitude tests.
2. Students who are required to sit entrance examinations at ESSEM shall do so in accordance with the provisions set out in the relevant regulations. Two written examinations are required: one compulsory examination in Biology (to be held on 9 March, 4 May or 1 July, depending on the application phase) and one examination in either Mathematics (to be held on 10 March, 5 May or 2 July, depending on the application phase) or Physics and Chemistry (to be held on 10 March, 5 May or 2 July, depending on the application phase). 3. The tests may be conducted through technological platforms and will take place on the dates specified in this notice.
4. The tests will be held in Auditorium 10 from 10:00 to 11:00.
