How does it work?

Guaranteed access to the 2nd year of the programme:

After the successful completion of 30 ECTS, the student gains direct access to the 2nd year of the study cycle.

Duration and academic periods:

Gateway Access Fall (September-January)

At the student's choice, ensuring sufficient time to arrange visas and relocation without missing classes.
