APPLICATION INSTRUCTIONS

The application must be submitted with the following documents:

Brazilian Candidates with Secondary Education + ENEM

- Identification document (Passport);
- Diploma and certificate of completion of secondary education, duly authenticated by the official education authorities of the country of origin and recognized by the Portuguese diplomatic or consular authority in that country, or authenticated with the Hague Apostille;
- Certificate of equivalence to Portuguese secondary education (to be requested from a Portuguese secondary education institution);
- Self-declaration, under oath, stating that the applicant does not hold Portuguese nationality and is not subject to any conditions preventing application to the competition for international students;
- Visa or Residence Permit/Card;
- Power of Attorney, when the application is submitted by a legal representative;

It is very important that documents are duly authenticated in Brazil, as it is not possible to authenticate Brazilian documents in Portugal.

Candidates of Other Nationalities with Secondary Education

All documents written in a language other than French, English, or Spanish must be accompanied by a translation into Portuguese, duly certified by the competent authorities.

- Diploma and certificate of completion of secondary education or equivalent, along with a statement confirming that the secondary education in that country allows access to higher education in the same country, duly authenticated by the official education authorities of the respective country and recognized by the Portuguese diplomatic or consular authority in that country, or authenticated with the Hague Apostille;

- Self-declaration, under oath, stating that the applicant does not hold Portuguese nationality and is not subject to any conditions preventing application to the competition for international students;

ENTRANCE EXAMS

1. Applicants who can provide proof of passing nationally recognized final examinations in the secondary education subjects corresponding to the entrance tests required for that year's admission to the programme are exempt from taking the aptitude tests.
2. Students who are required to take exams will do so in accordance with the provisions of the specific Regulations. Two written exams are required, one of which must be in Biology and the other in Mathematics OR Physics-Chemistry, as mentioned in the calendar.
3. The tests may be conducted through technological platforms and will take place on the dates specified in this notice.
4. The exams will take place in an auditorium to be designated by the International Office/Academic Services.

At the time of enrolment, all original documents, duly authenticated and previously uploaded to the online application platform, must be submitted. **No other documents than those submitted during the application will be accepted.**
